There are no restrictions on travel within Norway. Social distancing guidance remains in force. Face masks are now being recommended by Norwegian health officials for everyone riding on public transportation in Oslo and nearby Indre Østfold.

International Tourists

Anyone who travels to Norway must stay in quarantine for 10 days after arrival.

Exemptions are given upon arrival in Norway from areas in the Nordic countries and other EU/EEA/Schengen countries with sufficiently low transmission.
