All travellers entering Norway from countries or regions that are defined as high transmission areas will have to quarantine for 10 days.

All persons wishing to enter Norway from January will be required to provide detailed information when crossing the country's border

Testina Information

The government has imposed mandatory testing for COVID-19 for all travellers to Norway from January 2nd 2021. The test is also mandatory for Norwegian citizens. The test must be done as soon as possible, and within 24 hours after arrival at the latest. Where possible, testing should be done at the airport or other border stations. If that is not possible, the traveller must contact the local municipality or another test centre to arrange testing. Testing is free of charge. There are some exceptions from mandatory testing, including children under the age of 12, personnel with critical social functions, cross-border workers, long distance drivers and diplomats.

The Norwegian Institute of Public Health (Folkehelseinstituttet) website has a dedicated English language page on the coronavirus providing updates and guidance. Hotels, Bars & Restaurants

Most of the following tourism services are now open including: hotel, restaurants, spas, shops, malls, tours.

All bars and restaurants were ordered to maintain lists of all guests, to enable eventual infection tracking if needed

Events/Mass Gatherings

The government recommends that people should have no more than five guests in their home. This year, a maximum of 50 people can attend indoor services, as long as a distance of two meters can be maintained when singing hymns. No more 20 people are permitted to attend a private event hosted at a public venue.
