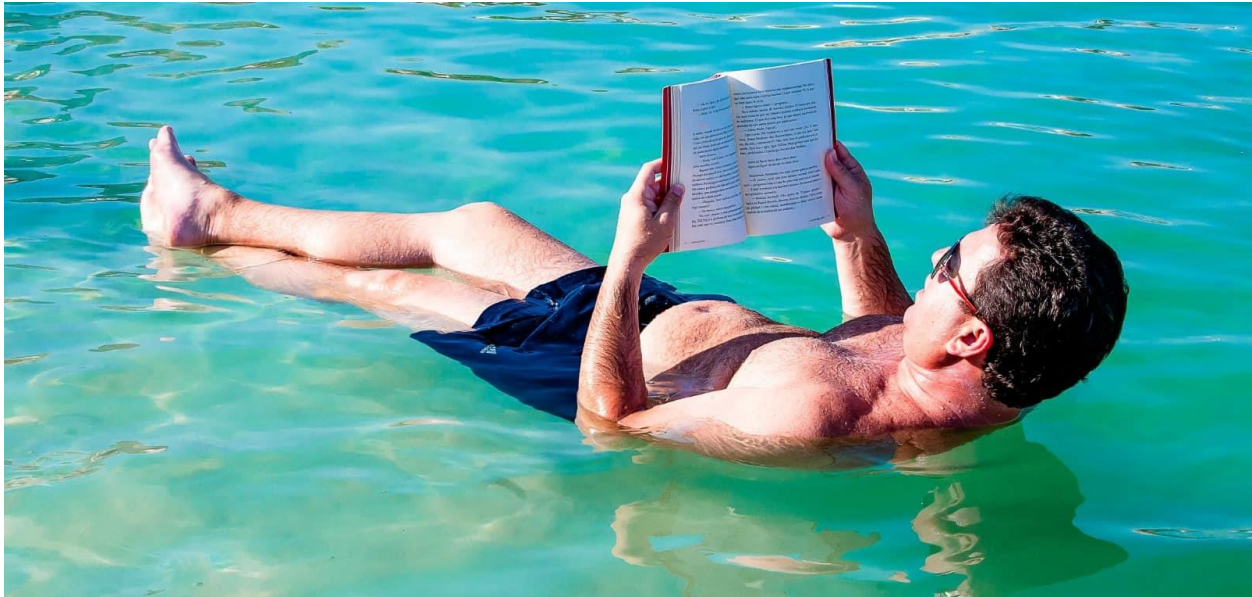


DEAD SEA
